The following information has been provided by the property and outlines the Accessible facilities available. AAA Tourism acts as a collection point for this information, however does not inspect the property to verify the information provided. Bathrooms

- level entry or ramp access is provided through the entry door
- an entry door with a minimum width of 800mm or wider when open is provided
- a minimum clear circulation space of 2500 x 1900mm is provided
- grab rails installed within reach of the toilet, at the back and side at a height of 800 – 810mm are provided
- a minimum space of 950mm beside the toilet is provided
- a shower area is on a level floor surface free of any step, hob or sliding door track
- minimum 1100 x 1160 floor space inside the shower and a minimum 1400 x 1400 outside is provided
- shower fittings that can be accessed from a seated position are provided
- a shower chair or seat is provided
- leg clearance underneath the hand basin is provided
- a mirror that can be used from a seated position is provided
- colour contrasting fixtures and fittings are provided

Bedrooms

- level entry or ramp access is provided through the entry door



- an entry door with a minimum width of 800mm or wider when open is provided
- minimum space of 2070mm x 1540mm to manoeuvre a wheelchair easily around all areas of the room is provided
- choices of bed types e.g. single, double are provided
- movable furniture, including beds to provide space for a transfer hoist if required is provided
- tea and coffee making facilities that can be accessed from a seated position are provided
- remote controls for appliances e.g. TV, Video, DVD, air conditioner, lights etc are provided
- power points and switches that can be accessed from a seated position are provided
- light switches within reach of the bed are provided
- clothes hanging rails at a low height are provided
- a storage area for mobility aids is provided
- large windows to maximise the view are provided
- a talking or large print alarm clock is provided
- a visual and/or vibrating alarm clock is provided

Car Parking

- A designated accessible car parking bay is provided close to the entry with a minimum width of 3200mm and minimum overhead clearance of 2500mm.

Conference and Meeting areas

- accessible car parking is provided near the entry
- clear concise, large print signage is located at the entry
- level entry or ramp access is provided through the entry door
- an entry door with a minimum opening width of 800mm or wider when open is provided
- movable furniture, including chairs and tables to for easy access are provided
- chairs with backs and armrests are provided
- tables that can accommodate a person sitting in a wheelchair are provided
- tea and coffee making facilities that can be accessed from a seated position are provided
- remote controls for appliances e.g. TV, Video, DVD, presentation screen, air conditioner, lights etc are provided
- power points and switches that can be accessed from a seated position are installed
- adjacent accessible 'break out' room for smaller groups are available
- wheelchair accessible presentation area or stage is provided
- an adjustable lectern and microphone is provided



- direct access to an accessible toilet is provided

Guest Services

- a tour booking service is available

Information Systems

- clear concise signage is provided
- signage in large print is provided

Laundries

- level access or ramp entry is provided through the entry door
- front loading drying machines are provided

Lifts

- a minimum internal floor area 1100mm wide x 1400mm deep is provided
- lift buttons are installed at height that can be accessed from a seated position
- movement detection beams are installed on the doors

Lounges

- level entry or ramp access is provided through entry door
- an entry door with a minimum width of 800mm or wider when open is provided
- movable furniture, including chairs and tables to provide easy access are provided
- chairs with backs and armrests are provided
- power points and switches that can be accessed from a seated position are installed
- wheelchair access to a computer terminal is provided

- the reception area
- accessible guest room
- any laundry
- any conference and meeting areas



Principal Entry Points

- level step free entry or ramp access is provided through entry door
- self opening doors are provided
- minimum 800mm width doorways are provided
- clear, concise signage is provided

Reception area

- level entry or ramp access is provided through entry door
- an entry door with a minimum width of 800mm or wider when open is provided
- clear manoeuvring space for a person using a mobility aid is provided
- movable furniture, including chairs with back and armrests are provided
- low height brochure and information stands are provided

Restaurants

- level entry or ramp access through entry door is provided
- an entry door with a minimum width of 800mm or wider when open is provided
- clear manoeuvring space for a person using a mobility aid is provided
- a low height service counter is installed
- movable furniture, including chairs with back and armrests are provided
- table service for ordering is available

Safety and Emergency

- information regarding emergency procedures is provided in each guest room in large print.
- fire extinguishers and fire blankets are installed at a height that can be accessed from a seated position.
- visible and audible alarms are provided in each room

Signage

- clear concise information on signage is provided in large print
